20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. (a) The Attorney General, as chief law
22	enforcement officer of the State of Alabama, is authorized to
23	direct and control all civil and criminal litigation
24	concerning the State of Alabama. This authority includes, but
25	is not limited to, the supervision of all civil and criminal
26	litigation and investigative activity in the state when such
27	litigation or activity involves the State of Alabama.

1 (b) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the 2 Governor shall not have the authority under Sections 12-17-184, 12-17-216, or 41-15B-2, Code of Alabama 1975, to 3 institute or direct the institution of a civil or criminal proceeding or investigation, nor shall the Governor have the 5 6 authority to appoint an individual through executive order or 7 otherwise to institute or direct the institution of a civil or criminal proceeding or investigation. Any such action taken 8 prior to the effective date of this act is hereby void. 9 10 Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable. 11 If any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part 12 which remains. 13 Section 3. This act shall become effective 14 15 immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 16
