ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Talladega County; authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall only apply to Talladega County.

Section 2. The sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages for on-premises and off-premises consumption by retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board is authorized in the county.

Section 3. All resolutions and ordinances relating to the sale, consumption, and possession of bottled or canned beer shall apply to draft or keg beer or malt beverages.

Section 4. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are hereby repealed. However, the provisions of this act are cumulative and supplementary and shall not be construed to repeal or supersede any laws or parts of laws not directly inconsistent herewith.

Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
