For 3 employees who retire other than for disability after September 30, 2005, except for those who retire on disability and who 5 are approved for Social Security Disability, the employer 6 7 contribution of the health insurance premium set forth by the board for each retiree class shall be reduced by two percent 8 for each year of service less than 25 and increased by two 9 10 percent for each year of service over 25 subject to adjustment by the board for changes in Medicare premium costs required to 11 12 be paid by a retiree. In no case shall the employer 13 contribution of the health insurance premium exceed 100 14 percent of the total health insurance premium cost for the 15 retiree." Section 2.
