SYNOPSIS: Under existing administrative rule, a cosmetologist licensed by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering may sponsor only one apprentice at a time.

This bill would allow a cosmetologist holding an instructor license issued by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering to sponsor up to three apprentices at one time.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering; to allow a cosmetologist holding an instructor license issued by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering to sponsor up to three apprentices at one time.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) A cosmetologist who, for at least three years, has held a current, valid cosmetology instructor

1 license issued by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and
2 Barbering under Section 34-7B-24, Code of Alabama 1975, may
3 sponsor up to three apprentices at one time, provided that the
4 licensee teaches and has taught in a school that is licensed
5 by the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and Barbering.

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
