SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, with certain exceptions, low-speed vehicles, including golf carts, may not operate on the public roads of this state.

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the Shelby County Commission and municipalities within the county to authorize and regulate the use of low-speed vehicles, including many golf carts, on certain public roads.

Relating to Shelby County; to propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the Shelby County Commission and municipalities within the county to authorize the use of low-speed vehicles on certain public roads.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:



1                   Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
2 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
3 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
4 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
5 the proposed constitutional amendment:

6                   "Relating to Shelby County, proposing an amendment  
7 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the  
8 Shelby County Commission and municipalities within the county  
9 to authorize and regulate the use of low-speed vehicles,  
10 including certain golf carts, on certain public roads.
