8	NAMING ACT 2009-571 THE JAMARI TERRELL WILLIAMS AC

10	WHEREAS, during the 2009 Regular Session, HB216,
11	sponsored by Representative Betty Carol Graham, was enacted to
12	create the Student Harassment Prevention Act; and
13	WHEREAS, Act 2009-571, now appearing as Chapter 28C
14	of Title 16, Code of Alabama 1975, requires the adoption of
15	policies in public school systems to prevent the harassment of
16	students; and
17	WHEREAS, Jamari Williams, a 10-year-old talented and
18	gifted dancer, honor roll student, and active member of his
19	church and native of Montgomery, Alabama, took his own life on
20	October 11, 2017, after suffering harassment and bullying at
21	school; and
22	WHEREAS, the Jamari Terrell Williams Foundation was
23	created in Jamari's name to work with city officials, schools,
24	churches, and other organizations to educate others about
25	bullying and suicide prevention in children and young adults;
26	it is fitting and appropriate that the Alabama Student

Harassment Prevention Act also be named in honor of young
Jamari Williams; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That in commemoration of the young life of Jamari Terrell Williams and the impact his story continues to make in the lives of other Alabamians, Act 2009-571 of the 2009 Regular Session, is named the "Jamari Terrell Williams Act"; a copy of this resolution shall be provided to the family of Jamari Terrell Williams so that they may know of our recognition of Jamari's life and our gratitude for their efforts to end bullying and harassment among young people in this state.
