2 ENROLLED, House Joint Resolution,
3 RECOGNIZING ALABAMA YOM HASHOAH COMMEMORATION ON
4 APRIL 10, 2018.

6 WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission will hold
7 its State Yom HaShoah Commemoration on April 10, 2018, at the
8 State Capitol in Montgomery, Alabama; speaker for the event
9 will be Governor Kay Ivey, and attending Holocaust survivors
10 and Second Generation members will be introduced; and

11 WHEREAS, Yom HaShoah was instituted in Israel in
12 1951 as a day of commemoration for the six million Jews who
13 perished in the Holocaust; and

14 WHEREAS, there is no institutionalized ritual for
15 Yom HaShoah; commemorations may include synagogue services,
16 communal vigils, and educational programs; lighting memorial
17 candles and reciting prayers for the departed are generally
18 part of the solemn ceremony; and

19 WHEREAS, the Alabama Holocaust Commission was
20 established by legislation in 1999 to foster understanding and
21 promote education about the Holocaust; our good friend and
22 colleague, Representative David Faulkner of Jefferson County,
23 is an active member of this commission; and

24 WHEREAS, among the duties of the Alabama Holocaust
25 Commission is the responsibility to enhance public awareness

1 of the consequences and significance of the Holocaust; the
2 enabling act of the Commission states that it is the policy of
3 the State of Alabama that Holocaust education is the proper
4 concern of all peoples; and

5 WHEREAS, events such as the 2018 Yom HaShoah
6 Commemoration are consistent with the mission of the Alabama
7 Holocaust Commission providing Holocaust education and
8 focusing on citizen involvement in this commemoration; now
9 therefore,

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
11 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That on this momentous occasion of
12 the Yom HaShoah Commemoration sponsored by the Alabama
13 Holocaust Commission on April 10, 2018, we recognize and honor
14 the memory of the lives lost in the Holocaust, and by copy of
15 this resolution prepared for appropriate presentation and
16 display, we recognize this solemn occasion as one to enhance
17 public awareness of the consequences and significance of the
18 Holocaust.
