- (b) The boards of trustees of each two-year and four-year institution of higher education in the state shall adopt rules and guidelines necessary to implement this section.
- (c) It is the intent of the Legislature that constitutionally created boards of trustees comply with the requirements of this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
